Introduction

The MILSET Europe General Assembly was officially opened by the welcoming words of MILSET Europe President, Antoine van Ruymbeke, and MILSET President Roberto Hidalgo.

All participants were invited to introduce themselves.

As per the statutes, only the members who have paid the membership fee are entitled to vote. Since 14 out of 20 member organisations in order are present or represented at the General Assembly, they constitute a quorum (> 50 %). They are marked with "X" in the column "Voting" in the list of attendees given in the annex.

Unless agreed otherwise, votes take place by raising hands and will be counted separately in the following order: in favour - abstention - against.

For a proposal to be passed, support from a simple majority (> 50%) is required, corresponding to a minimum of 8 votes in favour.

Eduardo Batista MILSET Europe Vice President acts as Electoral Commissioner.

1 Approval of General Assembly 2016 minutes

2 Organisation

2.1 Procedure

The procedure to become a partner or member is as follows.

An organisation can contact or be contacted by MILSET Europe if they share the same values and objectives as MILSET Europe. A candidature will then be presented first to the MILSET Europe Executive Committee and then at the MILSET Europe General Assembly, where the present members vote on it. If the candidature is accepted, the organisation becomes an associate organisation (former partner) of MILSET.

Associate organisation can be both governmental and non-governmental organisations.

After a year of association, an organisation may apply for membership if said organisation is non-governmental, the members at the General Assembly will deliberate on the membership application.

3 Finance

3.1 Financial report 2016

Antoine presents the financial report of 2016 on behalf of Alain Tournier, MILSET Europe treasurer, which does not include the entire volunteer job conducted by MILSET Europe. Balance of expenses and income is presented. Missions and Administrative supplies represent the biggest fraction. Main sources of income are both the membership fees and a fraction of ESE's registration fees. The balance of expenses and income generates an excess of € 2181,64 in one running account and € 4650,73 in one saving account.

On 31st December 2016, we had € 7.326,48 with a deficit of € 1.595,66 on the yearly cash flow.

In the future both accounts will be migrated to another bank/country.

The Financial report of 2016 was voted upon and the result is a unanimous approval.

The provisional budget of 2017 has a total of expenses of € 5.100 cover by incomes from membership fees and savings.

3.3 Budget 2018

The total budget for 2018 stands at € 6.500.

The need to invest time and effort into networking at the European level to increase MILSET Europe's visibility and potentially increase the chances of landing a generous grant at the European calls is stressed upon.

MILSET Europe has entered or joined European calls and has been successful in 2008. Since then, with increasing competition from bigger and better-resourced organisations, it has become increasingly harder to succeed in the applications submitted. MILSET Europe calls for support from the organisations in entering European calls, which requires a great amount of manpower and time-investment.

On the budget, the income from the membership fees does not correspond to the total number of members; this is because unfortunately not all members are in paying order.

Alain Tournier, MILSET Treasurer, is thanked for his work as treasurer of MILSET Europe for the past years. His professional attitude is praised.

The budget was put to a vote and approved unanimously.

The winner was Bernard li Recirdo from the Philippines. Antoine van Ruymbeke, project leader, and Denisa Kalužová, Art Director coordinated the contest.

The categories of the SPC are scientific phenomena and fauna.

Through this contest, MILSET Europe aims to create a leeway for youths to express creatively in pictures what they observe in science. A slideshow and posters of the winning pictures are available for exhibition during the member organisations' activities. Moreover, the pictures can be used by the organisations in their communication freely, provided the author is credited.
