# INTRODUCTION

The International Movement for Leisure Activities in Science & Technology in Europe (MILSET Europe) is a European non-governmental, non-profit and politically independent youth organisation, gathering the member and partner organisations of MILSET holding their seat in Europe. These organisations are active in the field of education of science and technology for young people.

MILSET was founded in 1987 in Quebec, during the first Expo-Sciences International. Due to its constant growth, the following regional branches have been created to-date:

- MILSET Europe
- MILSET Amlat (Latin America)
- MILSET Noram (North America)
- MILSET Africa
- MILSET Asia
- MILSET Vostok



MILSET Europe was formally established as the European branch of MILSET by youth organisations from 12 countries, on the 12<sup>th</sup> July 2004, during the 5<sup>th</sup> Expo-Sciences Europe in Dresden, Germany.

Nowadays, MILSET Europe congregates youth organisations from 30 countries (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Lichtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia and Montenegro, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine and United Kingdom) and is working to gather always more, aiming at offering more and higher quality opportunities to young people all over Europe.

Joining MILSET is adhering to its charter; a movement which participates in the local development of scientific and technical education in leisure time, promotes international cooperation, citizenship and peace, by practicing sciences and technology in a spirit of respect, mutual understanding and solidarity within different geographic and spiritual communities.

Thanks to MILSET, tens of thousands of young people have already met to exchange and make the most of their creations, discuss with researchers, youth leaders and entrepreneurs. These young people have developed projects together, discovered foreign languages and cultures, and have been trained to manoeuvre new technologies.

MILSET is an official partner of UNESCO.

# VISION, MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

## Vision

To inspire the youth through science and technology initiatives.

## Mission & Objectives

MILSET supports its member organisations to engage youth in science, technology, engineering, mathematics and the arts (STEAM) through motivation, cooperation, collaboration, and networking. We do this by:

- Helping member organisations create a local or national environment to motivate youth to be involved in STEAM;
- Connecting, supporting, and representing member organisations around the world;
- Stimulating and supporting international youth networking and cooperation through STEAM; and
- Providing member organisations with global opportunities to engage youth in STEAM.



## Activities

The activities are organised in two programmes:

- **Young Torches for Science:** Youngsters' oriented activities (Expo-Sciences, Science Camps, Youth Congresses, Contests, Other projects) where the torches are representing the light blossoming in each participant, which together make a fire.
- **Youth Science Factory:** Organisations' oriented activities (Youth leader congresses, Science Youth Vectors (SYV), Training Programmes, Other projects) where the factory is the place where we develop, create and realise the ideas and the activities.

MILSET Europe is collaborating with some organizations to develop new ambitious projects.

MILSET Europe promotes members and partners' activities supporting their opening to international participation and communication about external activities falling within the same objectives.

# EXPO-SCIENCES

A Young Torch for Science group of activities.

Expo-Sciences aim at promoting scientific projects created by children and young people through an exhibition in a multi-cultural environment, also allowing the participation of institutions which want to assist young people in their projects.

Expo-Sciences consist of a variety of activities in addition to the exhibition of the youngsters' projects, namely, cultural and scientific visits, leisure activities, workshops, animation, debates and lectures.

MILSET Europe is working on the development of a European survey about the Expo-Sciences.

## Objectives

- **Install and animate a space** to highlight youngsters, teachers and leaders' efforts and interest in research, science and technology innovation, fostering their motivation while contributing to their personal development;
- **Promote Scientific Culture** in a multi-cultural environment, allowing the sharing of experiences and good practices so as to achieve higher-standard scientific activities;
- **Establish relationships** with other institutions with similar goals through the development of scientific, technical and social projects in order to exchange ideas and create actions according to the needs of today's world, for the benefit of industry, the educational sector and society overall;
- **Be represented at an international level** via the young people's projects, allowing for the exchange of knowledge amongst the main target audience (i.e. youngsters).

Science Camps bring together a group of young people for a week or two to learn and discover science. This also allows the participants to learn about different cultures and ideas. These camps may be held on a national or international level and can be general or on a specific theme (eg. biology, astronomy, robotics), linking theory with a practical approach.

# Science Youth Vectors

A Youth Science Factory programme.

Science Youth Vectors programme aims to establish close partnership-based relations between different organisations involved in youth science and technology activity and to stimulate collaboration between them in different fields and on different projects. It is a platform, where any organisation affiliated to MILSET could propose the idea of a new interesting project and look for partner organisations in other countries.

Science Youth Vectors programme includes projects as short-term bilateral events where children from two different countries meet together to complete a project in a certain field of science. Such a form of cooperative activity is most useful for developing the children's intellectual, emotional and moral potential and one of the best ways to attract them to science and technology.

Whether you have an idea of a joint project which could be realised by teams of children from two countries and you need a partner organisation to make it real, or you are looking for some other kind of partnership (fund raising, exchange programmes, etc.) just publish a project.
